# Health Financing and Economic of Nutrition

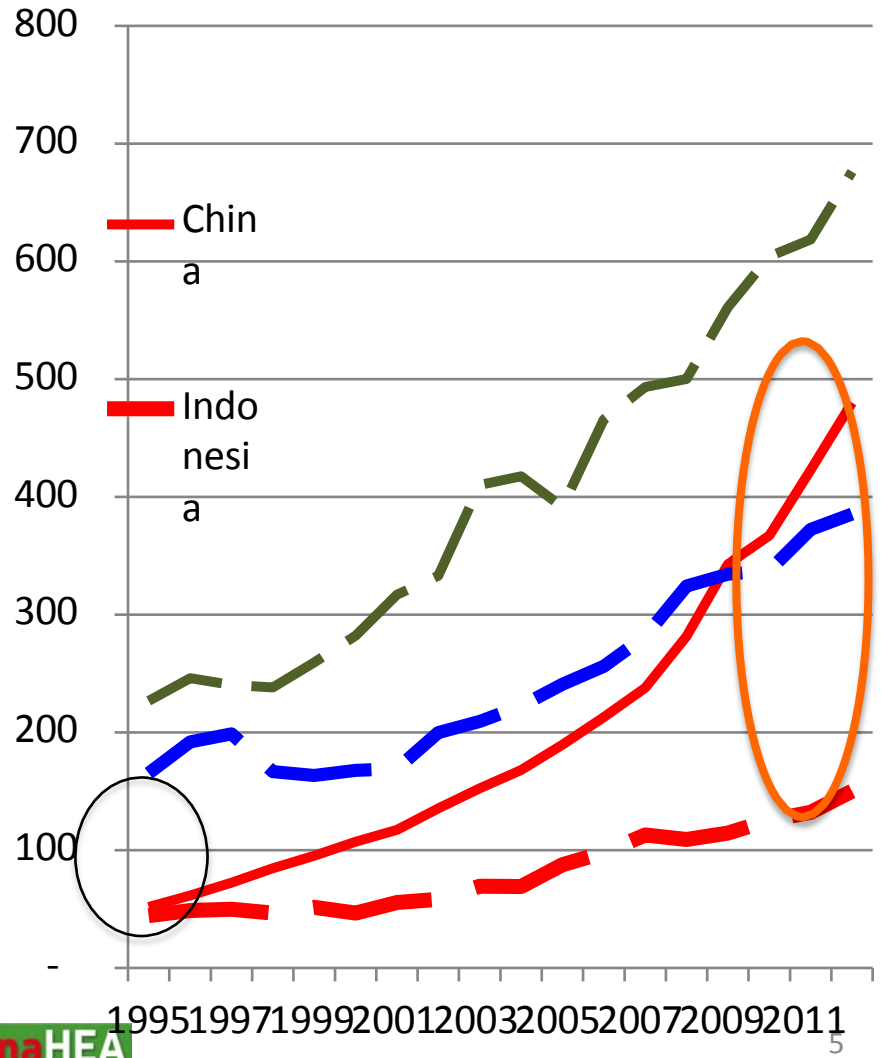
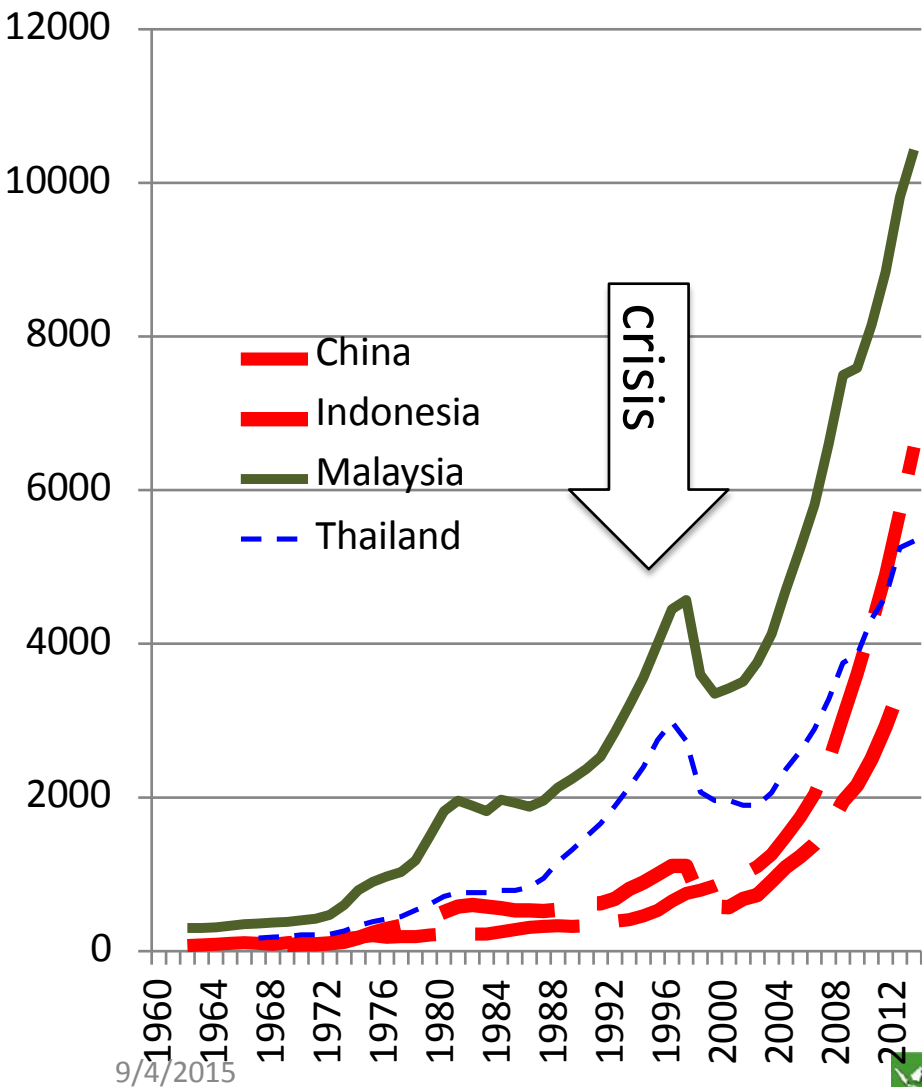
- In the cross road:
  - multiple payers → single payer, JKN/BPJS
  - Poverty, food insecurity, inadequacy vs obesity: → High NCD, expensive
- Chronic health care financing →
  - Shortage and misdistribution of human resources for health
  - Poor performance health care → high mortality
  - seeking treatments overseas

# Health Care Providers and Air Craft

- QZ8501 killed 156 people → news and discussions everywhere. Low costs flights?
- > 8,000 mothers died → few news and discussions. Chronic underfunded?

  - How many foreigner taking health care in Indonesia?

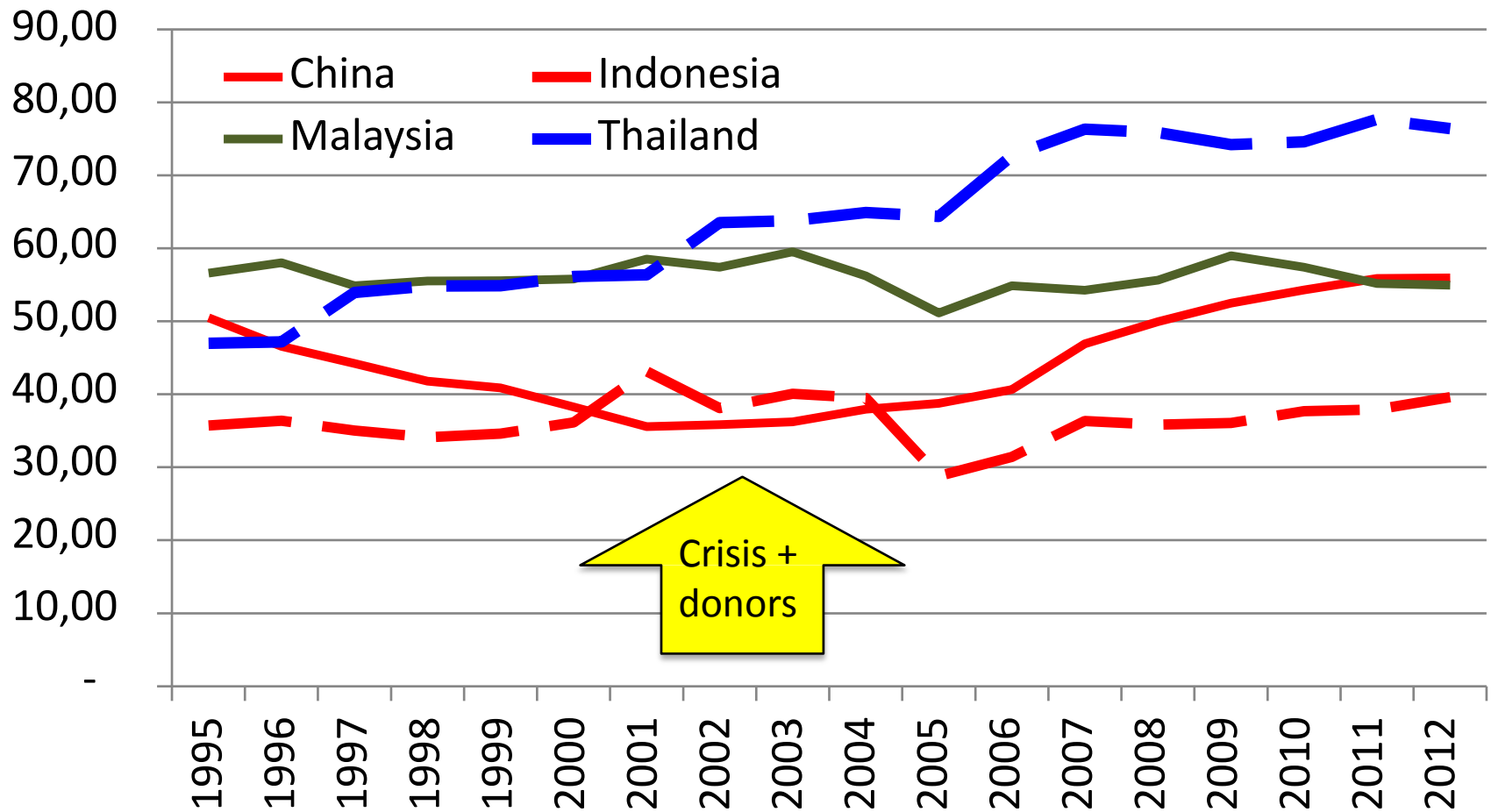
# Indonesia and Its Rivals -1
